Summary:

- Current Risk Preference/Tolerance Score is 61 for Mike (based on Risk Budget of -25% or tolerance for up to 25% loss in risk/equity assets)
- Jen's Risk Preference/Tolerance Score is higher indicating a higher Risk Budget (last scored at 75)
- Current Risk Number for total portfolio holdings is 54 out of 99 with a potential 12-month downside of 23% loss
- Results show capacity for increasing allocation to higher level of stock positions above current 67% total stock allocation in current total portfolio holdings (see Risk Capacity Score of 59 out of 99
- To reduce exposure to stock and maintain recommended range for reported Risk


